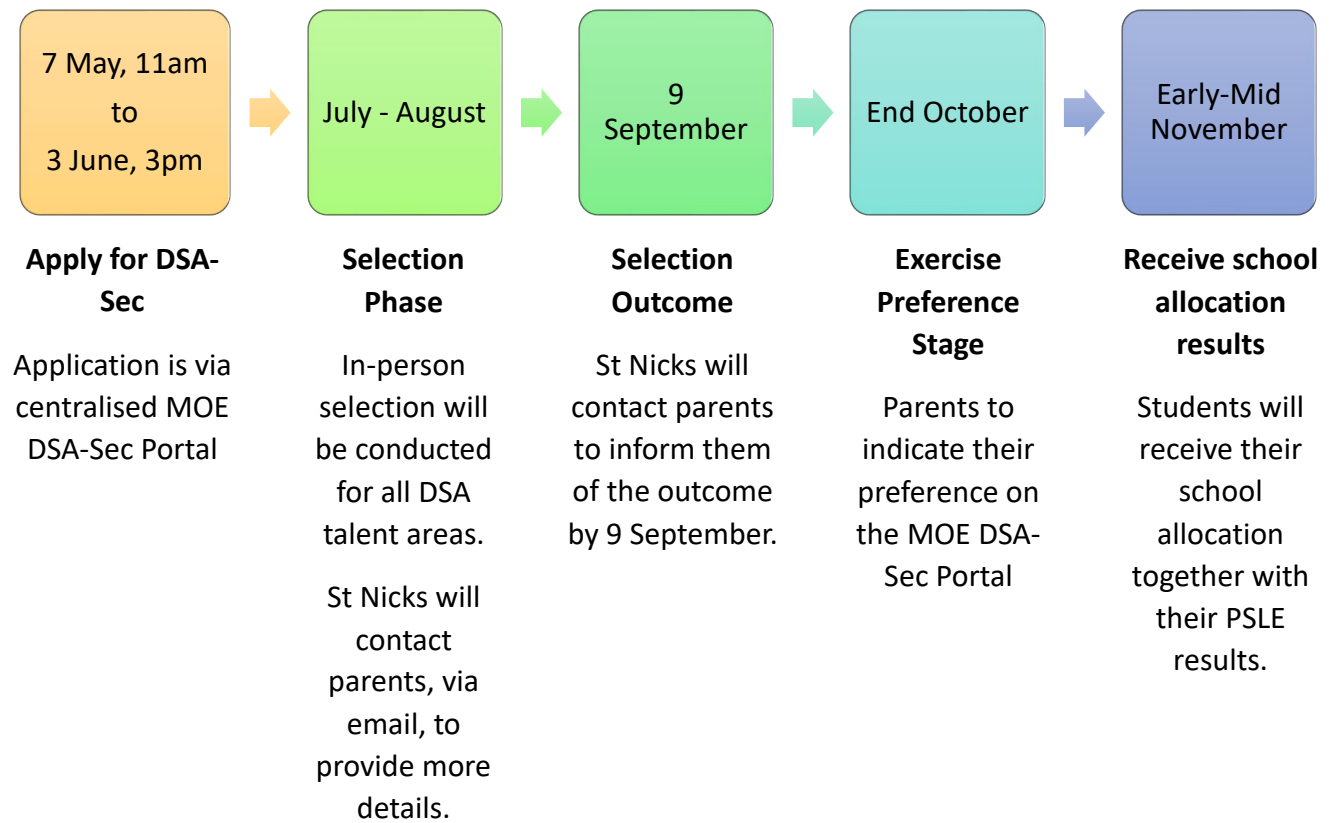


Overview of St Nicks DSA Selection Process

Given the prevailing national posture, DSA-Sec schools will be conducting **in-person** selection for all DSA talent areas.

DSA Timeline

Commitment from Successful DSA Applicants

Students who are successfully admitted to the school via DSA are expected to honour their commitment to the school (i.e. CHIJ SNGS) and programme, which is 4 years for the Singapore-Cambridge Secondary Education Certificate Programme or 6 years for the JIP (4 years in CHIJ SNGS and 2 years in EJC). They are expected to participate in the activities related to the talent area they are selected for from Year 1 to 4

DSA Selection Criteria and Process

Parents and students are encouraged to choose schools wisely based on the student’s aptitudes and strengths, bearing in mind the schools’ academic and non-academic requirements, and the programmes available to develop the student’s area of talent.

Applicants who do not have prior experience may also apply. The school will assess applicants based on our selection criteria, which may include assessing the potential of the applicants.

We seek parents’ understanding that **meeting all our selection criteria does not guarantee that your daughter will be shortlisted or given an offer.** Due to different profiles of applicants, selection/ shortlisting trends may differ year on year.
